All classes will meet (virtually!) with a parent volunteer throughout the week and will learn about a variety of skills including decision making, budgeting, problem solving and how maths 'is everywhere'. Our P3 and P6 classes will also be working alongside other classes from our Cluster primaries: Busby and Carolside. 
