Industrial Action Update

Parking in and around the School

The weather has meant that we have had an increase in cars dropping children to school over the last two weeks. As I mentioned last week it is imperative to be mindful of the children crossing the road at the **back gate** at Kirkwell if parents/carers are dropping off your child. The back gate is not supervised by staff members in the morning and we are concerned that an accident could occur due to lack of awareness or care being taken. Also please DO NOT PARK ACROSS DRIVEWAYS near the school. It is imperative that we have good relations with our neighbours in the community and consideration of their necessity to access their properties would be much appreciated.

Road Safety and Parking on Crompton Avenue/Safe Streets Campaign Reminder

A reminder that it is not permitted to drive down Crompton Avenue between 8.30-9.15am and 2.45-3.30pm as the school is part of a school free car zone scheme run by GCC. This has been in place since session 2019-2020. Please note that the Community Police have been issuing tickets throughout last session and will continue to support the school by reminding the public of the restrictions that are still in place and must be obeyed.

Car Park

Please do not use the school car park at any time for dropping off your child including breakfast club and after school (Exemptions for blue badge holders). Parents/carers and children must also use pedestrian areas only when accessing the school grounds. As I highlighted on other Newsletters there are other City Building staff who drive through the main gate from 8am and will be unaware that parents have been incorrectly using this gate as a pedestrian walkway. This could have serious repercussions and result in an accident.

Outdoor PE

Please ensure that on outdoor PE days children have appropriate clothing to keep them dry and warm. It would be advisable to provide a change of clothes in your child's bag in the event of them getting wet. We have a very limited supply in the school.

Health and safety

As I requested last week can you please ensure that your child does not bring electronic smart watches of any kind to school. A number of children have returned after Christmas with watches that can take pictures and/or record/film/facetime/video call etc. These devices are not appropriate for use in school. In addition we are not insured for any damages that may occur. Can we also request that no energy drinks, chewing gum or lollipops are brought in for snacks?
